- Every player must present his/her UNC 1-Card prior to playing.
- Teams will be placed in pools of 4 (dependent upon the number of entries received). Each team will play the other 3 teams in their pool once. The winner of each pool will be determined by record, head-to-head match up, and point differential. The winner of each pool will advance to single-elimination playoffs.
- DEFAULT POLICY: to default, call the Campus Rec. office at 843-PLAY no less than 2 hours before the scheduled game time. 2 defaults=1 forfeit (\$10 fine and dropped from the league).
- FORFEIT POLICY: dropped from league; ineligible for playoffs. To be reinstated, the captain must pay the \$10 forfeit fine within 2 business days at the SRC 101. If the fine is not paid then the \$10 will be charged to the captain's student account.
- Game time is forfeit time – there is no grace period.
- Apologies but due to the possibility of making an error, schedule information is not given out over the phone.

**IMPORTANT:** A \$20 forfeit deposit (\$5/\$10 of individual/dual sports) is due at time of entry. Only the person leaving the deposit can reclaim his/her deposit (or transfer it to the next sport) the day after his/her team has been eliminated or won the championship. Forfeit deposits, no matter how they were paid, will ALWAYS be returned by crediting your 1-Card and must be done by physically swiping the card. Teams must come into the office to get their refund before the end of the semester.
